From church to school to community treasure...



Community Museum:

Exhibits in the Little White School Museum tell the Oswegoland community's story from prehistoric times through the 21st Century. Highlights include specimens of *Tentaculites*

oswegoensis, the world's only fossil named for Oswego; a look at the community's education history; community residents' contributions during the nation's conflicts from the Civil War through Vietnam; as well as area farming, business, and religious history.



Historic Restoration: The Little White School served the

The Little White School served the community as a Methodist-Episcopal Church from 1850-1913 and an elementary school from 1915-1964. Starting in 1964,

the building slowly deteriorated until 1976 when the Oswegoland Heritage Association was established to restore the stately Greek Revival structure to its former grandeur. Its distinctive diamond-patterned window panes were just one of the building's elements reproduced by community volunteers before restoration was completed in 2002.



Research Center:

From family researchers to archaeologists, government officials and historians, the Little White School Museum's collections regularly prove to be virtually priceless resources.



.Heritage Park:

Starting in 1983, community residents donated old-fashioned heirloom perennials to enliven the gardens surrounding the museum with their colorful blooms from

spring to autumn.


